Result: Little Marlow won by 66 runs.

After last week's demolition of Emmbrook & Bearwood, Hurley had high hopes going into the local derby with Little Marlow at Shepherds Lane. The visitors won the toss and opted to bat first. Due to a late drop out and the late arrival of one player, Hurley took to the field for the first couple of overs with only nine men. Hurley's opening attack of Tanvir Yusuf and Raheem Dad picked up a wicket apiece with outside edges to Simoes behind the stumps to reduce Little Marlow to 19 for 2 in four overs. Anwar Mahmood (50) and Tahir Rashid (64)

added 78 for the third wicket. Wickets for Umar Zamman and Mushtaq Hussain got Hurley back into the contest at 138 for 5 after 32 overs. Farooq Hussain(58*), Umar Islam (22) and Zain Gill (20*) ensured that Little Marlow posted a competitive total of 244 for 7. The Hurley reply started at a good rate with Simoes (15) and Tanvir Hussain (14) going at a run a ball for the first half a dozen overs. Unfortunately for the hosts, three wickets in as many overs saw them stutter to 41 for 3. Jahangir and Mushtaq staged a recovery with a partnership of 39 but once again a trio of wickets put the brakes on. With the required rate increasing, Umar Zamman (48) and Umer Rashid (19) made a valiant effort to try and chase down the total but once Zamman fell, the writing was on the wall. The innings petered out to 178 with skipper for the day, Dad, being the last wicket to fall.
