A hot and humid day at Shepherds Lane saw both captains agree on a 35 overs per side contest. Hurley skipper Mo Basharat won the toss and opted to bat. An opening partnership of 22 between Pat Hinnell (4) and Yasir Gul (15) was ended by Binfield skipper Chris Jones, who trapped Hinnell in front. Gul was the next to go, giving catching practice to Will Guest at backward point off Suresh. The Hurley middle order of Akash Singh (13), Mubashir Nabi (12) and Hamzah Zaman (20) played with their usual entertaining style, but the experience of Paul Morgan (3-35) and Peter Henly (2-17) ensured that the run rate didn't get out of hand as regular wickets fell. Joban Singh, batting at 6, top scored with 38 and a useful 21 not out from Ajmal Ali saw Hurley to a total of 159 for 8. The threatened thunderstorm arrived during the tea interval and although the players rushed to get the covers on the strip, there was no further play as the square and outfield soon resembled a lake.
