After two successive victories, Hurley were brought back down to earth with a bump in the local derby at Pinkneys Green. The home side won the toss and opted to bat first in the hot, dry conditions. The fast outfield made for quick scoring and Pinkneys set the tone with 18 runs coming from the first three overs. Umar Zamman got an early breakthrough for the

visitors, bowling James Hemmings off his pads in the seventh over. This was the only success for the Hurley seam attack, and it wasn't until the introduction of leg spinner Tahir Kazmi that any further inroads were made into the Pinkneys line-up. Three wickets in his fourth over reduced the hosts to 97 for 4 and Hurley tales were up. Unfortunately for Hurley, debutant Hussain Bukhari had got into full flow and together with skipper Imran Tariq (51) added 121 for the fifth wicket. Phil Ridgeway returned to bowl at the pavilion end and ended the partnership, trapping Tariq leg before. Ridgeway's next over saw him pick up another three wickets and at 228 for 8 Hurley had hopes of bowling Pinkneys out for a modest total. Hussain Bukhari had other ideas and an unbeaten 174 including 25 boundaries and five maximums took the hosts' total to 283 for 8 at the declaration after 44 overs.

With a required rate in excess of a run a ball the Hurley reply needed a quick start, but this never came. David Simoes and Hassan Gul struggled to get the scoreboard moving and when Gul fell for 10 in the seventh over, there were only 18 on the board. Simoes survived a confident appeal for leg before from Fuller but failed to capitalise, bowled by Reddy for 9. This Hurley side, tend to follow the Ben Stokes philosophy, but without the same talent at the disposal of the England skipper and wickets fell at regular intervals. Of the middle order, only Umar Zamman (20) made any impact and when he holed out off Hussain Bukhari, any slim hopes Hurley had were well and truly buried. An entertaining knock of 76 from 39 balls by Jagdeep Singh at least ensured Hurley picked up a couple of batting points and a last wicket stand of forty with skipper Yasir Gul took the total to 149 when Jagdeep was stumped off man of the match Hussain Bukhari.
