For the second time this season, Hurley 2nds were involved in a low-scoring match against Fulmer. As in the previous encounter, Fulmer batted first and were dismissed for less than 130. Brijesh Lath (40) and Mustafa Hussain (30) made the bulk of the runs while Gurdev Singh (3-26), Kuljit Lally (2-20) and Joban Singh (2-22) were the pick of the bowlers for Hurley.

With a small total to chase and the threat of rain, Hurley sent out the big guns Ravi and Sukh to try and make early inroads. Sukh fell for 11 from six balls with the score on 18 and Ravi followed thirteen runs later. Aekam Singh showed some stickability but the loss of Happi and Joban, both without scoring, reduced the visitors to 44 for 5. Akash Singh joined Clive Williams in a partnership of 62 which appeared to have swung the match the way of Hurley, but just when it looked like they would see their side home, both fell leg-before with the

score on 106. Only another five runs were added for the loss of Gurdev Singh and Parvinder Hunjan, leaving last man Lally to join Greg Double and try and eke out the remaining 16 runs. While Double did his best Mike Walton impression, it was not to be as Fulmer skipper Lath trapped Lally in front to leave Hurley and agonising ten runs short of victory. The only good news of the day was that second place Holyport were rained off meaning Hurley maintained their place at the top of the table but missed out on a golden opportunity to increase their lead.
