Hurley made the trip to Ickenham to take on Ruislip Victoria in a must win game to keep their promotion hopes alive. Skipper Yasir Gul lost the toss and was asked to bat first on a green track that had sweated under the overnight covers. Umar Zamman and Hassan Gul opened against Umair Maan and Shan Gardezi. Zamman took a liking to Gardezi and smashed 13 runs off the second over. Gul was adjudged leg-before to Maan in the third with score on 14. Zamman continued to attack but inevitably holed out to Ans Ahmed at long on. 36 for 2 soon became 57 for 6 inside a dozen overs and Hurley looked doomed. Jagdeep Singh and Prasham Ghandi had other ideas. Batting in contrasting styles, Singh playing aggressively and Ghandi digging in, they dragged Hurley back into the match with a partnership of 234 for the seventh wicket. Maan returned to bowl Singh, with Ghandi still a run short of his century and three balls remaining. Phil Ridgeway sacrificed his wicket to get

Ghandi on strike, and he duly got the required single off the last ball of the innings to take his side to a very healthy 296 for 8.

The Ruislip Victoria reply started in spectacular fashion with Faridunfer hitting two boundaries and a maximum off the first three deliveries from Zamman. At the other end, Shan Gardezi was much more circumspect, playing out a maiden from Hamzah Ahmed. Faridunfer's fun was cut short when he edged Zamman to the keeper in the sixth over. Phil Ridgeway was brought into the attack to replace Zamman, bowling one over before switching ends, a move which proved pivotal as he proceeded to rip the heart out of the Ruislip line up, taking 5 for 43. Saaed Ajmal had Ismail Parwaz stumped and the writing was on the wall for the hosts. Ans Ahmed (24) and Fahad Ali (20), who had earlier retired hurt, provided some resistance, but Zamman and Ahmed returned to mop up the tail. The match ended with a one-handed catch at extra-cover by Jahangir Hussain, to give Hurley victory and move to second position in the table.
