A one-sided affair at Shepherds Lane on Sunday saw the visitors, Elmhurst CC, come away with the spoils. On losing the toss, Hurley were asked to bat first in a 35 over match.

The openers Yasir Gul and Shoaib Kayani, struggled to move the scoreboard with nothing to show from the first three overs. By the sixteenth over the score had crept up to 41, but three wickets in four deliveries from Alex Iliffe saw the departure of Kayani (17), Haider-Ali Baig (0) and Mubashir Nabi (0). Faizan Javed (8*) showed more stickability than many of his senior team mates and skipper Mo Basharat (15) was the only other player to reach double figures. Hurley were indebted to the 44 extras conceded by Elmhurst to enable them to reach any sort of total, finishing all out for 121.

The Elmhurst openers also struggled on a pitch with little bounce but with a low total to chase, they were never really in trouble. After the opening attack of Joban Singh and Joe

Graham were unable to make inroads, Baig was brought into the attack and removed Dewsbury (5) with his second delivery. Mason (45) and Maxfield (53) added 68 for the second wicket before the returning Graham got one through to bowl the former. The star performer with the ball was the young Faizan Ahmed who returned figures of 7-2-15-1 including the deserved wicket of Iliffe. Maxfield retired on reaching his half-century with only 9 runs needed for victory which was wrapped up in the thirtieth over when Finn Mercer hit Ajmal Ali over the square-leg boundary for a six.
