On a beautiful September day that had the BBC painting the weather maps bright red, Hurley hosted Wooburn Narkovians in an end of season friendly. Although Hurley scored over 300 runs, the match will also be remembered for some very good catches. Hurley skipper for the day, Mike Walton, won the toss and had no hesitation in batting first. Openers Josh Cole (46) and Haider-Ali Baig (69) made hay while the sun shone with an opening partnership of 85 in thirteen overs against a lacklustre Wooburn attack. The partnership was ended by Ben Sidders, thanks to a one-handed catch behind the stumps by Rhys Wheeler to dismiss Cole. The loss of Cole did little to slow the run rate as Mandeep Singh (53 ret) scored at a rate of 160 per 100 balls. Baig looked to be on his way to a hundred when the introduction of Ian Cuthbert who held a spectacular caught & bowled curtailed his innings. Jasdeep Singh made a maiden half-century for the club and Ravi Singh

with 34 from 10 deliveries ensured Hurley went passed the 300 mark and posted their highest total of the season.

Chasing over 8 an over always looked to be beyond a weakened Wooburn side and when Joban Singh reduced them to 7 for 2 in the fifth over there was no way back. Osama Munir picked up the third wicket, courtesy of a brilliant catch down by his ankles from Nigel Haines at slip. Two more wickets for Singh saw half the Wooburn side back in the pavilion with only 39 on the board inside 11 overs.

Kevin Dolan (7) and Ben Sidders (60) provided some stubborn resistance for Wooburn as Nigel Haines and Ravi Singh replaced the opening bowlers. Ravi got through the defences of Nolan and Haines had Sidders caught at long off by Mandeep. (102 for 7). Haines then had Gurdial smartly caught down the leg-side by Walton. Ben Hughes (29*) showed his senior team mates the way with some nice attacking shots, coupled with solid defence. Hurley swapped their bowlers around in an attempt to take the final couple of wickets to end the match. Mandeep had Darryl Still caught and the return of Osama wrapped up the victory with the first ball of his second spell.
