On both times that Hurley have hosted Binfield this season, rain has intervened. At least on this occasion a result was achieved. The visitors won the toss and opted to bat first, opening with Anthony Goff and Mikey-Allan-Canty. Goff survived a big LBW shout against Joban Singh off the first delivery of the match and the first few overs belonged to the bowlers with only 9 runs coming from seven overs. The batsmen gradually took control as Allan-Canty went on the attack and got the scoreboard moving. Both batsmen had a life with Allan-Canty spilled by the keeper and Goff dropped in the deep by Shoaib Kayani. The opening partnership reached 100 in the seventeenth over before Haider-Ali Baig trapped Goff in front. Baig picked up another wicket, thanks to a one-handed catch at cover by Joban and when the second rain break came, Binfield had reached 132-2. The skies cleared again but only another couple of overs were possible before the players were forced off with the score on 136 for 3. An early tea was taken, and the overs reduced, meaning Hurley were set DLS target of 160 from 20 overs.

Openers Kayani and Archie Wild got the Hurley reply off to a decent start with a partnership of 54 at a run a ball. The introduction of Pete Henly from the River End put paid to Kayani, caught at mid-wicket by Ben Clark. Clive Williams kept up the momentum with 19 from 14 balls before being bowled by Henly. Binfield skipper Paul Morgan replaced Garg at the Shepherds Lane end and came in for some punishment from Wild, the first three deliveries disappearing over the pavilion. Two balls later, Morgan got his revenge, as Wild missed another attempted slog-sweep and was bowled. Morgan's second over saw him pick up the wicket of Hamzah Zaman but also concede another three maximums as Baig went on the attack. With four overs remaining and 31 needed for victory, the match was in the balance. Amelia Hart conceded 14 from her first over but came back to pick up the vital wicket of Baig, caught on the mid-wicket boundary by Clark, leaving Hurley requiring 9 runs from eight balls. Two singles left 7 needed from the last over to be bowled by Dhruv Garg. A single from Nabi, followed by 2 from Ajmal left four from four and Ajmal finished it with a boundary off the next delivery to give Hurley victory by four wickets with three balls remaining.
