After a wash-out on the first week of the season, Hurley finally got under way with a home fixture against newly promoted Fulmer 2nd XI. A sterling effort by the new Hurley groundsman Maz Razzaq had the ground looking beautiful in the sunshine. The visitors won the toss and decided to bowl first. A solid opening partnership of 37 between Saeed Ajmal (46) and Haroon Malik (7) saw Hurley take the early initiative. The scoring rate is never a problem with this Hurley batting unit, it is usually a question of how many overs they can bat for. Wickets fell at regular intervals with six of the batsmen falling to catches. Ajmal fell four runs short of a half-century, having batted in a more classical style than many of his team mates. With the start they got, Hurley should have been looking at a score well in excess of 200 but with only Jagdeep Singh (33) and Mushtaq Hussain (16) out of the middle order reaching

double figures, it was left to Phil Ridgeway (13) and Yasir Gul (7) to ensure that Hurley passed 175 before being bowled out in the 44th over.

The Fulmer response never really got out of the starting blocks. Umar Zamman produced an in swinging yorker with his second delivery to knock over Sethu's middle stump. Shankaralingham (4) soon followed, falling to an unplayable delivery the clipped the off bail. After his first six overs, Zamman had four wickets for one run and the visitors were under the cosh at 39 for 4. When Zamman finished his nine over spell with figures of 9-6-8-4, Haroon Malik and Fiyyaz Mahmood took over to continue sending a steady trail of batsmen back to the pavilion. The only real hope for Fulmer was to try and reach three figures and pick up a batting point, but this proved beyond them as they were dismissed for 93 in the 29th over.
