After the success of both Saturday sides, the Sunday XI were unable to make it a clean sweep for Hurley on their first weekend of cricket for 2024. The home side won the toss and opted to bat first in the sunshine. An early setback saw skipper Shoaib Kayani run out with the score on nine. Mubashir Nabi only lasted two deliveries, slapping the impressive Khoul Bhuvi to cover. Akash Singh (27) joined Haider-Ali Baig (30) in a stand of 45 to get the Hurley innings back on track before Mike Ramsay swung a full-length delivery into the pads of Baig, giving the umpire a fairly easy decision to send him on his way. Singh continued to play some nice-looking shots but the regular clatter of wickets found the hosts struggling at 87 for 7. Mike Walton (3) joined Joban Singh in an eighth wicket partnership of 39 as the

batsmen looked to post some sort of defendable total. Singh finished a couple of runs short of his half-century as Hurley ended on 142 for 9 with Nigel Haines 3 not out.

The Hartley Wintney reply go off to a shaky start, losing Vijay Iyer for a single off the first delivery of the second over, thanks to a sharp catch at gully by Hamzah Zaman. Clinton Mogridge (28) and Ollie Steer (43*) got their side into a good position with a second wicket partnership of 67 as some of the Hurley bowlers struggled to find a line and length. It wasn't until the introduction of Baig that Hurley enjoyed any further success. Nigel Hanes was unlucky not to get an LBW decision against Steer, but this was balanced out by a rather fortuitous decision in favour of Baig to dismiss Ethan Ramsay. Despite three wickets for Baig, the visitors cantered to victory with seven overs and six wickets to spare.
