Hurley kept up their 100% start to the season with a comprehensive demolition of local rivals Little Marlow. With none of the home team at the ground 20 minutes before the start, the match inevitably started 20 minutes late. The hosts won the toss and opted to bat first. The Little Marlow innings progressed serenely for the first half a dozen overs with Uzair and Hashim punishing the odd short delivery from debutant Mohammed Sharam. Once Umar Zamman (3-21) got the breakthrough in the sixth over, clipping the top of Hashim's middle stump, a steady procession of wickets fell with Hurley hanging on to some good catches as the Little Marlow batsmen tried to hit their way out of trouble. None of the batsmen could find an answer to Hurley's spin trio of Haroon Malik (2-13), Fiyyaz Mahmood (3-3) and Phil Ridgeway (1-17) Skipper Uzair (31) survived a couple of close LBW shouts from Mahmood before finally falling for 31. The only other batsmen to reach double figures

was Zain Gill (12) before he fell victim to the left arm spin of Ridgeway. With the eleventh man not present, the innings petered out for 77 in the twenty-first over.

The Hurley reply started with JD Singh and Sharam, and when Singh hit the second ball of the innings over the long on boundary for six, the writing was on the wall. With 15 runs coming from the first over, and 43 from the first three, the only questions were how long the innings would last and could Little Marlow pick up a consolation wicket or two. The answer to the first was 32 balls and the second was no, as JD finished the match with a six and a four to leave him one short of a half-century from only 18 deliveries. Sharam finished on 25 from 14 with the whole match taking just over two hours to complete.
