Result: Hurley won by 154 runs

Hurley continued their 100% start to the 2024 season with a comprehensive victory over Knotty Green 2s. Visiting skipper Parth Adhayaru won the toss and invited the hosts to bat first. Hurley lost opener Mohammad Sharam to an ugly slog across the line to Upadyay in the second over before the scoreboard had moved. Saeed Ajmal (60) and Umar Zamman (16) dug in against some good bowling from Lalji and Upadyay who made good use of any moisture in the pitch to keep the batsmen honest. When Zamman fell in the seventeenth over, the score had crept along to 45. Haroon Malik (67) joined Ajmal and as the conditions got better for batting, they combined solid defence with withering punishment of anything short to add 104 in 15 overs for the third wicket. If Knotty Green had held their catches, it could have been a different story with Ajmal getting a couple of lives. Naeem Husain (71) continued the onslaught with nine boundaries and three sixes. As Hurley went all out attack, wickets inevitably fell, with Kuldeep Patel picking up a hat-trick. Hurley were bowled out for 283 with two balls remaining of the innings.

The Knotty Green reply started in similar fashion, losing a wicket before a run had been scored. A brilliant, one-handed return catch from Zamman off his third delivery accounting for Dev Barot. 0 for 1 soon became 35 for 4, then 46 for 5 as a procession of poor shots saw the middle order depart. Although Knotty Green scored quicker off their first fifteen overs than Hurley had done, the loss of wickets hampered any realistic chance of victory. Two wickets in consecutive deliveries for Aman Singh reduced the visitors to 73 for 8 in the twenty-second over and they looked like being bowled out for less than 100. A defiant 59 from Chandresh Kotiya, assisted by Luke Patton (11) ensured that Knotty Green picked up a couple of batting points, but when Kotiya was bowled by Sharam it was only a matter of time and the end came in the twenty-ninth over when Fiyyaz Mahmood bowled Patton.
