On the day that England's hopes of winning the Euros were dashed, Hurley and Hetairoi played out an exciting match at Shepherds Lane. Thanks to Mubashir Nabi who played an absolute blinder, Hurley almost pulled off an unlikely victory. In truth, if Hurley could have held their catches it would have been a different result. Having agreed a 30 over per side match, Hurley won the toss and elected to bowl first on a green tinged track. While Mo Basharat (1-6) kept it tight from the River End, Ajmal Ali (0-44) struggled to find any consistency from the Shepherds Lane End, conceding 18 wides in his 6 over spell. With Simon Evans (65) and John Ball (31) taking full advantage of Hurley's lacklustre fielding, the visitors raced to 101 inside 16 overs before Mo Basharat returned to get Evans caught at extra-cover by his own skipper who was sub-fielding. Having feared they would be chasing a massive total, Hurley did well to peg back the scoring with Nigel Haines (3-30) and Nabi (6-25) taking the last six wickets for only ten runs.

The Hurley reply started slower than the England football team, with only 20 runs coming from the first ten overs for the loss of Pat Hinnell (9). Yasir Gul (0) and Hamzah Zaman (4) came and went leaving Shoaib Kayani to join Haider-Ali Baig with 148 required from 17 overs. The pair added 63 in eight overs to keep Hurley in the Hunt before Kayani (23) fell to Thathapodi. Steve Matthews (2-43) dismissed Baig (43) and Ali (10) to leave the hosts needing an unlikely 68 from 6 overs. Nabi (39*) and Walton (10*) threw caution to the winds with some big hitting from Nabi and some almost suicidal running between the wickets to leave 16 to win off the last over to be bowled by Ball. With Nabi on strike Hurley felt they were in with a chance, but excellent death bowling by Ball conceded only three from the final over to secure a thrilling victory for Hetairoi.
