Hurley 2s put on a dominant performance to secure a comprehensive 133-run victory over Little Marlow 2s. Winning the toss and electing to field first, Little Marlow were unable to contain Hurley's batting lineup, which amassed a formidable total of 268 runs. In response, Little Marlow were bowled out for 135 runs in 35.1 overs, falling significantly short of the target.

Hurley's innings was marked by a series of strong individual performances that collectively built a daunting target. The opening partnership laid a solid foundation with Akash Singh scoring a composed 42 off 56 balls, hitting 6 boundaries and a six. Jasdeep Singh added a brisk 30 off 41 balls, including 3 fours and 2 sixes, before falling to Furqan Hussain. Ravi Singh then played a pivotal role in the middle order, scoring a quickfire 48 off 40 balls with 8 boundaries. His innings provided the necessary impetus and helped stabilize the innings after the fall of early wickets. The middle order continued the momentum with Umair Butt contributing 17 off 16 balls. Joban Singh, the captain, made a valuable 31 off 24 balls, but it was Mandeep Singh's aggressive 47 off just 28 balls that stood out. His innings, featuring 6 fours and 2 sixes, propelled Hurley to an imposing total. The tail end also chipped in, with Zubair Butt scoring 23 off 18 balls. Awais Hussain was the standout bowler for Little Marlow, taking 6 wickets for 52 runs in his 8.3 overs.

Chasing a big target of 269, Little Marlow's innings got off to a rocky start, losing early wickets and struggling to build partnerships. Opener Farhan Hussain scored a quick 24 off 21 balls, with 6 boundaries, but fell to Joban Singh, setting the tone for the rest of the innings. Paul Fisher and Aadam Ali were dismissed cheaply by Kuljit Lally, who was in sensational form, taking 4 wickets for 34 runs in his 9 overs and was unlucky to not get a fiver as a couple of chances were put down off his bowling. Richard Tinsley and Rayhan Hussain could not contribute significantly, leaving Little Marlow reeling at 46 for 4. The middle order saw some resistance from Mike Carter, who scored a patient 30 off 48 balls with 5 boundaries, and Tom Lathey, who top-scored with 45 off 50 balls, hitting 7 boundaries. However, their efforts were not enough to chase down the target, as wickets continued to tumble. Ravi Singh and Joban Singh both bowled economically and effectively, taking 2 wickets each. Ravi Singh's 6.1 overs yielded just 14 runs. The innings eventually folded at 135 runs, with the last wicket falling to a run-out by Mandeep Singh.

Hurley 2s exhibited a commanding performance with both bat and ball, demonstrating depth in their batting lineup and efficiency in their bowling attack. Key contributions from multiple batsmen, backed by a disciplined bowling effort, secured them a comprehensive victory.
