Pinkneys Green 2s won the toss and elected to bat. Pinkneys began their innings cautiously, the first five overs were exceptionally tight, with Hurley's opening bowlers Joban Singh and Kuljit Lally delivering five consecutive maidens. This initial pressure led to the early dismissal of Christopher Heyes, who was caught by Mandeep Singh off the bowling of Joban Singh for a duck, leaving Pinkneys at 0 for 1. Despite this rocky start, Harry Wood anchored the innings with a superb 93 runs off 119 balls, including 12 fours and 2 sixes. His innings was crucial in stabilizing Pinkneys' innings. However, the team struggled to build momentum, losing wickets at regular intervals. Sridhar Balachandar provided support with a brisk 37 off 48 balls, but other batsmen failed to make significant contributions.

Chasing a target of 185, Hurley's start mirrored their opponents' struggles as they lost early wickets. Akash Singh and Rahulpreet Singh provided a steady start, but after Akash was trapped lbw by Anthony Fuller for 23, the team faced a series of quick wickets. Rahulpreet Singh managed 33 runs before being dismissed by Sid Iyer. The innings took a crucial turn with the arrival of Mandeep Singh, who played a match-winning knock. Mandeep scored a commanding 85 not out off just 58 balls, including 8 fours and 4 sixes, showcasing both aggression and composure. Despite losing partners at the other end, Mandeep ensured Hurley stayed in the game. Hurley faced a tense situation as they were reduced to 113 for 6, but Mandeep's resilience saw them inch closer to the target. The tailenders supported him just enough to cross the finish line, with Hurley achieving the target in 37.4 overs, finishing at 188 for 9 and getting the victory by 1 wicket.

In a thrilling encounter, Hurley 2s emerged victorious against Pinkneys Green 2s by 1 wicket. The match began with a string of five maiden overs by Hurley, setting the tone for a tightly contested game. Harry Wood's brilliant 93 for Pinkneys laid a challenging target, but Mandeep Singh's unbeaten 85 ensured Hurley's narrow win. The bowlers from both sides delivered notable performances, but it was Mandeep's innings that ultimately made the difference, guiding Hurley to a dramatic victory.
