The local derby between Littlewick Green and Hurley turned into a comfortable win for the visitors, although they didn't have it all their own way early on.

Adrian Hurley won the toss and invited Hurley to bat first. With the first three batsmen back in the hutch with only 33 on the board as Oscar McCulloch and Yasir Ali bowled with accurate pace, there was the danger that Hurley would have one of their disaster days. However, Saeed Ajmal (52) and Adnan Liaquat (58) stopped the rot with a 97 run partnership. Zak Sullivan

replaced Ali and struck with his first delivery as Liaquat top edged, and Adrian Hurley ran back to take the catch. Jaspreet Singh (23) added fifty with Ajmal for the fifth wicket and with 32 from Tahir Kazmi, Hurley reached 237 for 9 in the thirty-eighth over and with Umar Zamman not ready to bat, the Hurley innings was closed.

With 58 overs to chase the target down, the match was in the balance as McCulloch and Dave Brooks went out to face Fiyyaz Mahmood and Phil Ridgeway bowling with the old ball. Mahmood struck in the fifth over, bowling McCulloch. With no further success for the spinners, Zamman was brought on and took the new ball with devastating effect, taking 5 wickets to knock the stuffing out of the Littlewick line up. With Dave Brooks (29) the only Littlewick player to pass 25, the innings faded away to 156 all out in the thirty-fourth over with Liaquat coming on to help Zamman mop up the tail.
