The annual fixture between Hurley and Kep Doon ended in a thrilling finish with the visitors prevailing by the narrowest of margins.

Hurley were asked to bat first and openers Shoaib Kayani and Mike Walton made a solid start on a difficult pitch. They saw off the opening attack of Paul Trennell and Alex Cudworth and by the drinks break had progressed the score to 70 without loss. With a solid base, Hurley should have posted a good score but the loss of Kayani (46), caught by Gunasekar off Felix Burton precipitated a collapse of epic proportions as Hurley contrived to lose 10 wickets for 63 runs. Josh Cole was involved in two run outs, selling Walton down the river then karma striking as Akash Singh did the same to him. The middle order failed to capitalise on the start they had been given. Hamzah Zaman and Mamoon Majid both fell first ball as some rash shots led to their downfall. It was only thanks to a last wicket partnership of 17 between Ajmal Ali (16) and Nigel Haines that Hurley managed to get past 140, a total that was around forty runs short of a par score.

Opener Jack Burton was the mainstay of the Kep Doon innings with 47. Roger Goff (25) and Matt Huggan (35) also made good contributions at the top of the order. By the drinks break, Kep Doon were well placed at 81 for the loss of Tait. After drinks Hurley turned to Nigel Haines as they searched for wickets, and he struck with his second delivery to bowl Goff as the Kep Doon keeper stepped to off to try and hit over the leg side, only to lose his middle stump. A couple of overs later, Haines dismissed Burton in similar fashion. Matt Huggan was run out attempting a quick single to Haines at backward point. With another 23 runs needed and six wickets in hand, it should have been a stroll in the sunshine for Kep Doon, but Hurley suddenly had belief that they could pull off an unlikely victory. Two more wickets for Haines and one for Basharat saw Kep Doon still needing two runs, with Hurley needing two wickets. Akash Singh had Felix Burton caught by Tasadiq with the scores level and a tie was on the cards. With all Hurley's first choice bowlers having finished their overs the skipper turned to Majid with strict instructions to bowl straight. Unfortunately, Majid's first delivery was speared down the leg side, giving the keeper no chance and handing victory to Kep Doon. Jasper Burton finished unbeaten on 13, the hero of his side's victory.
