The eagerly awaited top of the table clash between Ruislip Victoria and Hurley did not disappoint.

The visitors won the toss and opted to bowl first. Ruislip Victoria made good early progress before losing both openers to Aman Singh with 35 runs on the board. Fahad Ali survived a confident appeal for a catch behind and made the most of it, adding 107 for the third wicket with Waleed Iqbal (75) at a good rate and the hosts looked to be on course for a big score. Saeed Ajmal broke the partnership thanks to a good catch at slip by Haroon Malik to dismiss Ali. The introduction of Kunal Himalaya (5-21) turned the game in Hurley's favour, firstly trapping Iqbal leg-before and then blowing away the middle order as the hosts lost seven wickets for forty runs in a dozen overs to finish on a disappointing 200 all out in the forty-third over.

Ruislip Victoria set about defending their below par total, opening the attack with Umair Maan and Iqbal, who sent back both openers inside five overs with only ten runs scored. When Iqbal had Malik caught behind and Farooqi's pace proved too much for Ajmal, Hurley slumped to 47 for 4 and the hosts were cock-a-hoop sensing victory as the required rate had climbed to above five per over and Hurley's batting was looking fragile. Kuldeep Singh (84) and Kunal Himalaya (43) turned things round with a partnership of 107 in seventeen overs. When Himalaya was bowled by Shan Gardezi in the thirty-fourth over, only 47 more were required. Some big hitting by Kuldeep, including four massive sixes, put Hurley firmly in control and only three more runs were needed when he skied an Ans Ahmed delivery to Rameez in the thirty-ninth over. Aman Singh wasted no time in finishing the match, hitting his first delivery over the square-leg boundary to give Hurley a victory that moves them to the top of the Chilterns Division 1 table with two matches left to play, ensuring that their fate is now in their own hands, and victory against Harpsden and The Lee will give them the league title.
