Hurley 2s secured a commanding victory over The Lee 2s, winning by 143 runs. After electing to bat first, Hurley posted an imposing total of 319 all out in 42.3 overs, courtesy of a stellar innings from Mandeep Singh, who scored a magnificent 130 runs off just 82 balls. In response, The Lee struggled to build any substantial partnerships and managed to score only 176 for 9 in their allotted 45 overs.

Hurley's batting effort was anchored by a superb knock from Mandeep Singh, who hit 7 fours and 11 sixes in his scintillating innings of 130 runs. He was well-supported by Rahulpreet Singh, who contributed a brisk 52 off 35 balls, and Akash Singh, who added a solid 38 off 58 balls at the top of the order. Despite a middle-order collapse, where wickets fell in quick succession from 308 for 5 to 319 all out, Hurley managed to post a massive total. Extras were also a significant contributor, with The Lee conceding 48 extras.

Chasing a daunting target of 320, The Lee's innings never gained momentum. Hurley opened their bowling attack with skipper Joban Singh from River End, with Osama Munir and Kuljit Lally posted in 1st and 2nd slip, who were described as the widest ever Hurley slip cordon seen by DW. Opener Mike Harris put up a valiant fight with a half-century, and Aziz Chaudhry provided some resistance with a 63-run knock however was lucky enough to be let off for a very confident shout for caught behind. The rest of the batting lineup failed to contribute significantly, with four batsmen dismissed for single-digit scores. Hurley's bowlers were relentless, with Rahulpreet Singh leading the charge by taking 3 wickets for just 10 runs in his 7 overs.

In their final league match, Hurley 2s dominated with both bat and ball, securing a comfortable victory and ending their season on a high note ensuring the runners-up spot in Chilterns League Division 2.
