The annual visit of Harrow Wayfarers to Shepherds Lane ended in a victory for the visitors. The captains agreed on a traditional declaration game with Hurley winning the toss and opting to bat first. Things didn't go according to plan as the hosts found themselves at 32 for 4 after the first 11 overs. Of the top order, only opener Akash Singh (55) made a significant contribution. After a shaky start Singh got into his stride and played some glorious shots. Skipper Mo Basharat, promoting himself up the order, justified this decision with an unbeaten 22 to hold the innings together, sharing in partnerships of 59 with Akash and 84 with Joban Singh (71). When Joban fell, stumped off Luke Pollard, Basharat made a sporting declaration considering the slow over rate bowled by the Wayfarers. Steve Hallam was the pick of the bowlers with 3 for 6 from half a dozen overs at the start of the innings.

The visitors' reply got off to a good start with a partnership of 125 in nineteen overs as the Hurley opening attack struggled to find any consistency. Aman Singh finally got the breakthrough with a

quicker delivery to get through the defences of Sanju Sodha (46). Dharmakeethi soon followed to a leg-side stumping off the young left-arm spinner Faizan Javed (2-29) who continues to impress. Despite another wicket for Javed and one for Nigel Haines (1-34) Wayfarers were guided home by skipper Luke Pollard (17*) and Ben Dale (22*) with just over two overs to spare.
