On a grey and overcast afternoon at Shepherds Lane, Hurley CC 2nd XI claimed a tense three-wicket victory over Emmbrook and Bearwood CC 2nd XI with 11 balls to spare. In a high-scoring thriller, Hurley chased down a stiff target of 268 in 43.1 overs, showcasing both resilience and depth in their batting line-up to earn a crucial win in their league campaign, having been asked to field first after losing the toss.

Emmbrook and Bearwood's innings was anchored by an outstanding century from Matt Booth, who struck 108 off 98 balls, including 15 fours and 3 sixes. Booth combined well with opener Connor Simpson (63), as the pair added a crucial 59-run stand for the third wicket. Although wickets fell at regular intervals, Ravi Balakrishnan chipped in with a rapid 33 from 27 balls to take the visitors to a formidable 267-7 from their 45 overs. Hurley's bowlers shared the wickets, with Joban Singh claiming 2-33 and single strikes from Rahulpreet, Harpreet, and Salman Khan.

In reply, Hurley's innings got off to a stuttering start with the early dismissal of Akash Singh, but a blazing 77 from Rahulpreet Singh laid the platform for the chase. His innings featured 8 boundaries and 5 sixes and set the tone for Hurley's aggressive approach. Useful contributions from Parvinder Hunjan (40) and lower-order runs from Jasdeep Chahal (53*) and Salman Khan (27*) guided the hosts over the line in the 44th over. Hurley recovered from 174-6 to chase the target calmly thanks to the composed partnership between Jasdeep and Salman.

Toby Morgan was the standout bowler for Emmbrook and Bearwood, returning impressive figures of 5-64 from his 8.1 overs. Charlie Sawyer chipped in with two wickets, but the rest of the attack struggled to contain the flow of runs on a fast-scoring ground.

In the end, it was Hurley's ability to hold their nerve and build a key partnership when it was the most needed that proved the difference. With contributions throughout the batting order and a composed finish, they secured all 22 points in a hard-fought and rewarding victory, an important result in their push for success in Division 7B.
