Hurley continued their climb up the TVCL Div 6B table with a hard-fought victory against bottom side West Reading at Shepherds Lane. The visitors won the toss and elected to bat first, posting a decent total of 261 built around good innings from skipper Adam Davidson (70) and Zain Choudhary (60). Umar Zaman broke the opening partnership, bowling Munir Khan (21) with the score on 42. A century partnership between Davidson and Chaudhary helped put West Reading in a good position before Davidson was caught behind off Haroon Qayyum. The visitors continued to score at a good rate despite wickets for Qayyum (4-46) and Mohammad Fayyaz (2-33). The visitors' innings ended in the final over when Ahsan Iqbal (32) was stumped off Saeed Ajmal.

Hurley's opening pair of Adnan Shazad and Hassan Gul posted 54 for the first wicket before Wasim Akram re-arranged Shahzad's furniture. All of the Hurley batters made a start, but the only player to pass 50 was Kunal Himalaya, who held the innings together. When Waqas Munir was caught behind off Ahsan Iqbal, Hurley were still 33 runs short of victory and a tense finish was on the cards. Qayyum (56*) and Umar Zaman (12*) held their nerve and saw their team over the line with three overs to spare.
