The annual Hurley Past v Present fixture saw a win for the 'old boys'. This fixture is always more about catching up with old friends than the result, but it is still keenly contested. Featuring three generations of the Hinnell family, with club President Patrick, playing against a nephew and two great nephews, with ages ranging from 11 to 70+, as well as three Taylors. By agreement, the current Hurley team batted first. Jono Patrick was an early victim of birthday boy Ahmad Akhtar,

who although not as quick as his father Naeem, bowled a good line and length. Alex Simon, despite his tender years made a solid 11 from 44 balls before falling to the medium pace of Ian Dawkins thanks to a diving, one handed catch by James Taylor. Alex was replaced by his father Bert, who could not match his son's exploits with the bat, falling to his second delivery, top edging Dawkins to give Mike Walton an easy catch behind the wicket. Clive Williams (45) held the innings together, sharing a 91-run partnership with Shoaib Kayani (59). The partnership was broken by Josh Cole, who got one through Williams to knock out the middle pole. Kayani became young Akhtar's second victim, advancing too far down the track and being stumped. The final total of 169 for 7 from 35 overs ensured that the Past team would have to bat well if they were to win.

After a sumptuous tea provided by Dave Walton, the Past opened their reply with skipper Josh Cole and Pat Hinnell. Cole scored his 21 runs at a run a ball before being undone by the left arm spin of Faizan Ahmed. At the other end, Hinnell took his time with 17 from 50 balls, falling to a catch behind the wicket off his great nephew, Tom Simon. Going in at three, Gurj Brench (38) looked like he had never been away, despite not picking up a bat for 20 years, he showed that class is permanent, with some splendid cover drives. Along with Brench, Craig Dawkins (46) and Ian Dawkins (22*) put the Past team in sight of victory before Craig fell just short of a half-century, leaving James Taylor (6*) to finish off the job with Ian to ensure victory with 6 overs to spare.
